The Luxembourg Centre for Systems Biomedicine (LCSB) is an Interdisciplinary Research Centre of the University of Luxembourg. It combines experimental and computational approaches to analyse complex biological systems and disease processes with a strong focus on neuropathology including neurodegeneration and epilepsy. The overarching strategy of the LCSB is to combine systematically experimental and theoretical approaches to develop mechanistic disease models.

The 7th edition of this international conference on Neuroinflammation will now take place in Luxembourg from 11 to 13 May 2023. Through a comprehensive scientific programme with a broad basic and clinical focus, the conference will address the entire spectrum from basic aspects of Neuroinflammation and Neurodegeneration to state-of-the-art and emerging treatments. A special emphasis will be put on the many roles of immune mechanisms in neurological disease and their potential as diagnostic or therapeutic target.

Speakers from diverse areas of Neuroinflammation will present their most recent research insights in order to stimulate vivid discussions and idea findings for future collaborations

Moving this renowned conference series to Luxembourg offers new grounds for scientific exchange, joint strategies and collaborative actions with the Neuroinflammation community on an international level.






WHAT IS THE CONFERENCE APP?

In addition, some features are particularly interesting for sponsors and exhibitors,




THE VENUE: **BELVAL CAMPUS**

The convergence of researchers, students and companies in one place constantly provides new food for thought.






The conference will take place in the Maison du Savoir (literally House of Knowledge), the central building of the University of Luxembourg.
